

What is CSA 2010?

Comprehensive Safety Analysis (CSA) 2010 is a major Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) initiative to improve the effectiveness of the Agency's compliance and enforcement programs. CSA 2010 will help FMCSA and its state partners contact more carriers and drivers, use improved data to better identify high-risk carriers and drivers, and apply a wider range of interventions to correct high-risk behavior.

FMCSA's CSA 2010 initiative will change the way carrier and driver performance are measured. CSA 2010 replaces SafeStat with a new Safety Measurement System (SMS) that measures the previous two years of roadside violations and crash data. With SMS, every inspection counts, not just out-of-service violations, and both driver and carrier safety performance are monitored using seven new Behavioral Analysis Safety Improvement Categories (BASICs).

The SMS will group the safety performance data of motor carriers and drivers into the seven BASICs which are:

1. Unsafe Driving
2. Fatigued Driving
3. Driver Fitness
4. Controlled Substances/Alcohol
5. Vehicle Maintenance
6. Improper Loading/Cargo
7. Crash Indicator

Based on a carrier's score within each BASIC, the SMS triggers when the Agency should begin to intervene with a motor carrier. CSA 2010 will mean more contact between FMCSA and you, the carrier.

Intervention steps by increasing severity include:

- Warning Letter
- Targeted Roadside Inspection
- Off-Site Investigation
- On-Site Investigation - Focused
- Cooperative Safety Plan
- Notice of Violation
- On-Site Investigation - Comprehensive
- Notice of Claim/Settlement Agreement

Full implementation of CSA 2010 is scheduled to start in November of 2010. Are you prepared?

- Interfaces with the FMCSA's SMS.
 - » Driver roadside inspection and accident data is updated as it becomes available from the SMS and is automatically imported into the service ensuring you have access to the most up-to-date information on your drivers.
- Accident and roadside inspection tracking tool.
 - » You can ensure the accuracy and consistency of roadside inspection data received from your drivers with what is on file in the SMS.
- Self-audit tool that determines your safety fitness rating and recommends any necessary corrective actions.
 - » Audit tool allows you to perform audits using internally gathered roadside inspection and accident data to generate a safety fitness rating.
 - » Corrective action plans help you identify what steps need to be taken to resolve any violations that are discovered during an internal audit.
