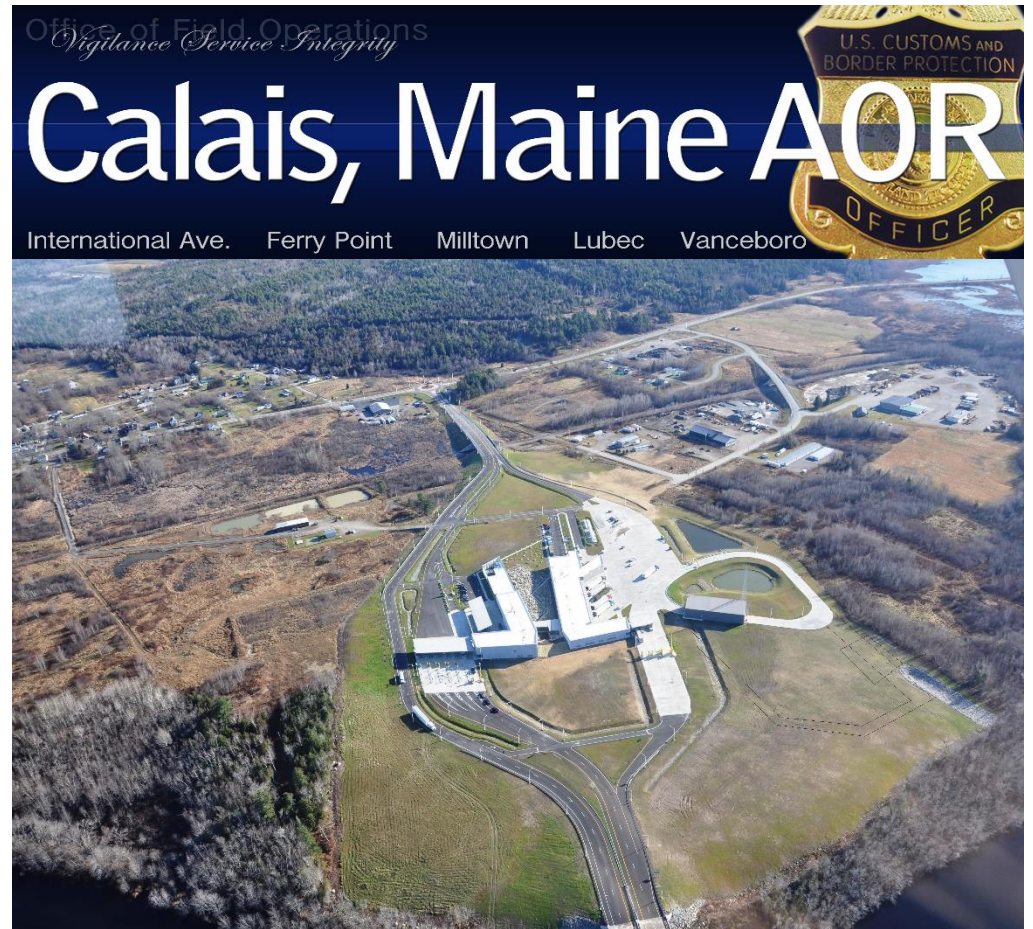

Automated Commercial Environment - ACE

- Single Window for Trade

Developed approx. 15 years ago

- ACE/E-Manifest submitted to CBP 1 hour prior to arrival
 - FAST submitted 30 min prior
 - 2 hour FDA Prior Notice
- Submitting Truck, Trailer, Driver, and shipment information
- ACE/E-Manifest exceptions

- Officer Initiated

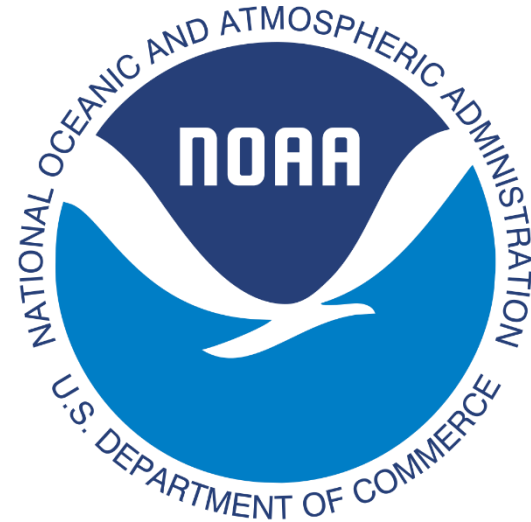

User Fees - DTOPS

- <https://dtops.cbp.dhs.gov/main/#>
- Decal & Transponder Online Procurement System
 - Unlimited crossing per calendar year
 - Cost effective if crossing more that 40 times
 - Cost: \$406.56 per CY
 - Transponder is unique to a vehicle VIN
 - AQI fee \$7.55 per trip
 - CBP fee \$5.75 per trip

PTI – Priority Trade Issues

- Agriculture and Quota
- Antidumping and Countervailing Duty
- Import Safety
- Intellectual Property Rights
- Revenue
- Textiles/Wearing Apparel
- Trade Agreements



Other Issues

- Entry Not Of File (ENOF)
 - Broker did not receive paperwork
 - SCN/PAPS number error
- Missing documentation, permits, certificates, etc.
- Helpful tips
 - Driver has entry number before crossing
 - Points of contact – after hours and weekends
 - Utilize Broker web sites for tracking
- Point to Point violations
