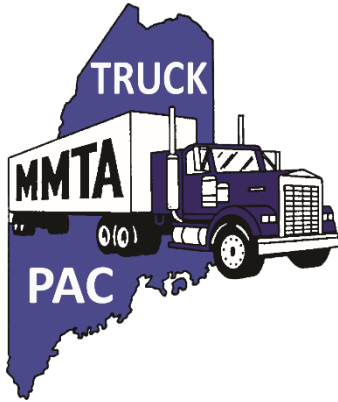


2020 Maine Truck PAC Golf Scramble



Welcome to the 2020 Maine Truck Pac Golf Scramble. We appreciate the support of our Annual Sponsors, Major Sponsors, and Hole Sponsors. Please take the time while playing to note who has sponsored each hole.

We also appreciate our Members and Vendors who are playing and thank you for your patience and understanding with the changes to this year's event necessitated by COVID. We endeavor for all to have a good time and enjoy the day and each other's company, while supporting the Maine Truck PAC.

The safety of all involved is a top priority. In order to conduct the event safely while following State guidelines, the following measures for gathering and play have been put in place.

PRIOR TO PLAY

- All players are asked to pay in advance for golf and mulligans by calling the office or asking to be invoiced during registration.
- We will not have a 50/50 raffle this year.
- Teams and Starting Holes will be posted at the course at the scorer's board, and also emailed before play to each person registering.
- Players are asked to arrive no earlier than 8:30 for a 9am starting time.
- Players are asked to report to their carts upon arrival.
- Carts will be staged as follows:

Holes 1-6: Parking lot in front of club house

Holes 7-12: Cart path adjacent to first T-box

Holes 13-18: Dirt Road in front of first T-box

- An MMTA Staff member will be in your designated area to answer questions or to provide assistance.
- Carts will be cleaned and disinfected before arrival.
- Players are required to wear masks while in carts and should not alternate drivers once play has begun.
- Masks will be available for anyone who needs one.
- At 8:50am, teams will be directed by MMTA staff to proceed to their starting holes.
- A horn will blow at 9am to begin play.

FORMAT OF PLAY – BEST BALL SCRAMBLE

- Men will tee off from white tees and women will tee off from green tees.
- Best tee shot will be selected and then players will scramble until a ball is holed. Maximum score on any hole is a bogey – so you may pick up after exceeding par.
- If purchased in advance, two mulligans per player may be used at any time, except on tee shots for hole-in-one prizes.

- Flags must remain in holes at all times during play.
- Rakes are not provided at bunkers. Lift clean in place within the bunker is allowed.
- Sanitizer will be provided with closest to hole tapes for disinfecting tapes before and after use.

ADDITIONAL EVENT DETAILS

- Water will be provided in each cart and at holes 7 and 16.
- Natanis staff will provide BBQ, drinks, and water at hole 7 and 16 intersection. Beer will be available for purchase.
- When event is completed, designate a “team captain” to bring the score card to the scoring board outside the screened in building.
- There will not be food, drinks, or award presentations after golf.

PRIZES FOR WINNERS OF EVENT AND RAFFLES PRIZES

- All raffle prizes will be drawn during play, and winner’s names and prizes will be posted during the event.
- Players who win raffles must claim their prize before departing.
- All players are encouraged to depart after claiming any raffle prizes.
- Scores will not be posted at the course in order to discourage congregating.
- Once tabulated, winning scores will be posted on MMTA’s website and emailed to all players.
- First, Second, and Third Gross and Net prizes will be mailed to the winning team captain.
- Closest to the pin prizes will be mailed to winning players.
