### What is a Data Q

•DataQs allows you to request and track a review of Federal and State data issued by FMCSA that you feel may be incomplete or incorrect. The system automatically forwards your Request for Data Review (RDR) to the appropriate office for resolution and collects updates and responses for current Requests.





Why do you want to have an inspection and/or violation reviewed? Please choose the reason why you want inspection information reviewed. Do NOT submit a new request for an already closed request unless instructed to do so. To review inspection event types, click here.

- Never received a copy or lost the report
- Citation associated with a violation on an inspection
- Violation is incorrect, listed multiple times, or missing Intermodal Equipment Provider (IEP)/shipper information
- Not mine (wrong motor carrier or driver)
- Inspection missing from my report
- Duplicate (same inspection listed multiple times)
- Inspection report contains incorrect information / Other

#### **Confirm Request Type**

You have selected "Violation is incorrect, listed multiple times, or missing Intermodal Equipment Provider (IEP)/shipper information".

By choosing this option,

You believe that the violation is incorrect as listed in the FMCSA systems or listed multiple times in error. Inspection reports include violations at the time of the inspection, which carriers or drivers are then responsible to fix. Once fixed, a violation is not considered incorrect and will remain on the record.

#### **Important Notice:**

Violation codes are updated in FMCSA systems to support the agency's program. To ensure uniform implementation, these changes are not applied retroactively and DataQs requests prior to implementation will not be upheld.

## Is there an appeal process?

Right now there is not a formal appeal process. This is currently being reviewed by FMCSA now but it is recommended that states adopt one.

Our process in Maine for appeal is informal but seems to work for the most part. If a carrier disagrees 100% with the decision they can reach out to MMTA or the commander of the CVEU for the State Police. We will convene a board with a MMTA representative, a member of FMCSA and the commander of CVEU to review the challenge and collectively return a response back to the carrier.

This process, though rare seems to work for our State but can always be improved upon.
