Dear Friend,

I hope you are ready to help defeat the “most radical socialist” agenda in America slated for Portland’s ballot in November. We all heard what’s at stake in the upcoming election, and we need your help to defeat thirteen ballot initiatives that will drastically change the future of Portland. If passed, these questions will hurt the hard-working citizens of Portland, including **our tipped servers, delivery drivers**, and the thousands of individuals who get local residents to doctor’s appointments and home safely at night by driving for services like Uber and Lyft. All those changes are disguised in a minimum wage ballot question that also establishes a new City Department of Labor.
